The Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS®) developed by ATI testing is a standardized test that provides objective measurement of an individual's specific ability with content areas that measure entry-level academic readiness of health science program applicants. The ATI TEAS®, *Version 7* is the newest version of the exam and evaluates performance within the indicated areas.

- Reading
- Mathematics
- Science
- English and Language Usage

What score do I need to make?

The admission requirements for the Baton Rouge General School of Nursing specify **a minimum of 65%** Total Score for ATI TEAS® exam. ATI TEAS® total score **will not be rounded up**.

How can I prepare for the test?

The TEAS® Study Manual and practice tests are available for purchase on the ATI website at www.atitesting.com along with a TEAS® Study Package that combines the manual and practice tests at a discounted price. These study materials can be located by clicking on the online store and then shop by TEAS products.

What if I have already taken the TEAS®, Version 7 and want to use that score?

You will need to have your official TEAS transcript sent directly to the Baton Rouge General School of Nursing from ATI. You can purchase a TEAS Transcript either from your ATI student account or the ATI's Online Store for a fee charged by ATI. TEAS 6th edition scores will be accepted through May 15th, 2023.

Can I take the TEAS® more than one time?

Prospective students may take the TEAS® exam a total of three times within a year at 14 to 30-day interval to allow appropriate remediation.

How do I register to take the TEAS®?
